

SKYECROFT TENNIS COURT RULES

GENERAL

Tennis courts are for the exclusive use of Skyecroft Homeowners Association ("SHOA") members and are subject to the following rules. All guests of members must be accompanied by a SHOA member ("Member"). Only Members in "good standing" may use the tennis facilities. Good standing requires that Homeowners Association dues and fees be paid in full and that no outstanding ARC violations exist.

RULES

These rules must be observed by all Members and guests using the tennis courts.

- The tennis courts may be used daily until 10pm.
- Proper attire is required. Only soft soled tennis shoes are allowed. Running and track shoes
 or black soled shoes are not allowed, as they mark up the surface on the courts. Shirts must
 be worn at all times on courts.
- No food or GLASS is allowed on the courts. Drinks must be in plastic containers.
- The courts must be cleaned and all debris removed after use. Empty the trash can when necessary.
- Instructors paid or otherwise, must be handled as a SHOA Member guest. Instructors must take care to minimize disruptions to adjacent court when in use.
- Courts are on a first come first use basis.
- Profanity, throwing of rackets and other such emotional outbursts will not be tolerated. Failure
 to comply with this rule may result in removal from the courts and forfeiture of tennis
 privileges.
- No pets are allowed in the tennis area.
- Children who are not playing tennis are not permitted on the courts.
- No bicycles, strollers, playpens, skateboards, skates, roller blades or similar equipment are allowed on the tennis courts.
- No more than 4 individuals may be on one court at one time.
- Playing time should be limited to one (1) hour if another member is waiting to use the courts.
- The tennis facility may not be used as a money making facility by SHOA Members or any other organizations or HOA's.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to amend these rules and regulations without notice.
